## Student Led Conferences

Sent home in your child's report was information relating to the opportunity provided by the school to engage with your child/children in their student led conference. To book an opportunity to listen to your child talk about their learning we are again using an internet-based booking system called Parent Teacher On-Line (PTO).

Using this system you will be able to book your child's/children's student led conference times that suit you best from any internet-connected computer. A computer will be available in the front office foyer during school hours if you do not have internet access at home or elsewhere. The site will go live on **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July at 9am.**

Student led conferences will be held for:

- **Prep students** from 3.45pm to 7.00pm on **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> July**
- **Grade 1/2 students** from 3.45pm to 7.00pm on **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July**
- **Grade 3/4 students** from 3.45pm to 7.00pm on **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> July**
- **Grade 5/6 students** from 3.45pm to 7.00pm on **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July**

Student led conferences will be of **15 minutes duration**. A number of student led conferences may be happening in the room at the same time your child is delivering their conference to you.

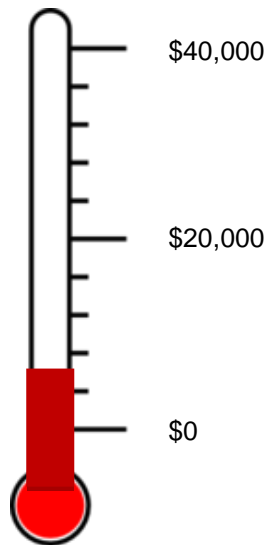

# Traffic Safety

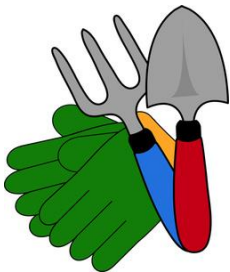
Parents and carers contribute to traffic problems around our school. Please help by obeying the parking restriction signs, keeping clear of the children's crossing and never double-parking outside the school.
